Leech													Marabou leech in black, olive or brown size 4 -10. Rabbit leech brown or black size 2 - 6.
Midge													Larva: Blood midge. Pupa: chromonids green and red, CDC emerger, CDC buzzer. Adult: Griffiths gnat, flashy gnat, shuttlecock midge. All sizes 10 -18
Redside Shiner													Zonker with silver body and gray or olive feather 4-6, Matuka, Wooly Buggers and other Streamers in black, yellow, red and olive, size 4 -6.
Scuds & Sow Bugs													Scuds: Scud patterns in olive/gray, tan, orange, pearl shrimp, 12-18 Sow Bugs: Davies sow bug, soft hackle sow bug, glow bug or egg pattern, white, gray, pink, sizes 14-18
Caddis													Goddard caddis, elk hair caddis, yellow and orange stimulators, stimi-chew-toy, all size 6-10.
Callibaetis (speckled dun)													Nymph: pheasant tail, flashback pheasant tail, hares ear. Emerger: callibaetis cripple. Adult: purple haze, parachute adams, green sparkle dun, callebaetis comparadun. Spinners: callibaetis spinner, hen spinner.
Damselfly													Damselfly nymphs: green marabou damsel, green wooley bugger, red tipped green wooly worm. Adults: braided damsel, parachute damsel. Damsel emerger in green or blue all 8-12.
Terrestrials													Ant, flying ant, foam ant in black and red 12-16. Foam black beetle, ringo, CDC baby beetle 12-16. Grasshopper patterns 6-12, moth or white elk hair caddis 6-12, bee 10-12.
Fish Eggs													Any egg patterns 8-14. Cream color yarn egg with a yellow spot.
